All conference events will take place at the Crowne Plaza. There is a complimentary car parking for all attendees on scheduled event days only. The hotel has a 24-hour fitness studio, outdoor pool, and full-size tennis court.

Getting from Airport to Hotel

IMPORTANT: All visitors to Australia need a valid passport and an Australian visa or Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) Visa. Click here for more info.

From Gold Coast Airport to hotel: Gold Coast Airport, located at Bilinga on the Gold Coast's southern end, is approximately 25 kilometers from Surfers Paradise. There are multiple transportation options from which you can choose. An airport bus service operates from Gold Coast Airport. Look for route 761 or 777 to reach Surfers Paradise in approximately 45 minutes. There are taxis and Ubers available just outside the airport terminal entrance. There is no hotel shuttle. <u>View Gold Coast Transportation Options</u>

From Brisbane Airport to hotel: A convenient way to transfer to the Gold Coast from Brisbane Airport is using the Airtrain service. Trains depart regularly from the Brisbane Airport to the Gold Coast, where connections can be made from Airtrain stations via G:Link or bus connection to popular Gold Coast locations. You can also choose to transfer from Brisbane Airport by bus, private transfer, or limousine. Brisbane Airport is located approximately 80km from the Gold Coast and transfer times are dependent on traffic conditions, so check when you make your booking how long it is likely to take. <u>View Airtrain Information</u>

Registration Hours

Practical Information

Currency: Australian dollars (AUD). Australia has a goods and services tax on purchases (10%), but you may claim this and the Wine Equalisation Tax when departing.

Electricity: 240/250 volts AC 50Hz Universal outlets for 110 volts (shavers only) standard in hotels, apartments, motels. **Emergency:** Dial 000 for police, ambulance, fire.

Smoking: Queensland has strict tobacco laws. There is no smoking in indoor public places.

Time Zone: Gold Coast is located in the Australian Eastern Standard Time zone (GMT +10 hours).

Weather: Autumn temperatures fall between 16-26°C (61-77°F). Hinterland areas may be cooler and wetter.

Virtual Platform

All registered attendees (virtual and onsite) will have access to the virtual platform. On Monday, May 20 you will receive an email with your log-in details to access the virtual platform. All registered attendees have access to the virtual platform where you can view all posters, chat with poster presenters, watch on-demand videos of recorded oral sessions, and chat with fellow attendees. Getting Around

Taxis and Ubers are readily available. Buses, trains, and G:link trams operate on the Translink network and the easiest way to ride is to buy a Go Card ticket which can be purchased at any 7-eleven store, visitor information services, most train and tram stations plus select news agents. G:link trams also use Smart ticketing, so a tap of your preferred credit card or smartphone can be used for payment. A Go Explore card is another great option for travelers - allowing unlimited use of the Translink service for just \$10 a day and \$5 for kids. A tram and bus stop are located directly in front of the hotel: <u>Florida Gardens</u>.
